Culture: Blue Mist is adapted to most soil types, but is especially suited well drained soil. It is a popular plant for home gardens but can become invasive.

Growth Habit: It flowers in spring and summer, but it is in the fall that it puts on its most magnificent show, attracting Queen butterflies, migrating Monarchs and many others

Bloom: The bloom has a blue flower and readily works well as a filler or groundcover.

Notes: This plant spreads quickly. It's also easy to divide and move to a new area after the last frost
