Growth Habit: 'Penelope Rose' is an open shrub rose. It grows easily in nearly any soil and rarely has pest or disease problems.

Bloom: This rose blooms heavy in spring, rests in summer and repeats blooming in the fall. It has dark green foliage that is dense and spreads vigorously.

Notes: This rose was discovered in 1924. It's hardiness zones is 6 - 9, fertilize in Spring just before new growth begins and keep moist until completely established. Average water needed during growing season.
