Culture: Cold hardy perennial with stunning red flowers. Blooms summer till frost. An improved sterile hybrid with distinctively lobed leaves.

Growth Habit: Hibiscus will grow huge flowers on thick stems to form shrubby plants 5' wide and tall. The 'Lord Baltimore' Hibiscus will have a tropical look. The foliage is a glossy rich green in color. The flowers on the 'Lord Baltimore' are large red up to 10" wide. It grows well in neutral to acid soils.

Bloom: Bright red can bloom up to 10" wide.

Notes: Cut back freeze-damaged wood in early spring and mulch well.
