GREEK YOGURT BANANA & BLUEBERRY PANCAKES

INGREDIENTS

1 banana, mashed 1/4 cup nonfat plain Greek yogurt 1/2 cup gluten-free rolled oats 1 medium egg 1tsp. coconut extract 1 Tbs. unsweetened almond milk 1/2 tsp. baking powder 1/2 cup blueberries

- 1. Wash hands and clean cooking area. Pre-heat skillet or griddle to medium-high heat.
- 2. In a large bowl, mash banana until completely smooth. Combine all ingredients together except blueberries. Mix well together then fold in blueberries and pour into a spouted measuring cup.
- 3. Spray cooking spray over skillet and pour batter. Pour just enough to make a small ball and flatten into a round shaped pancake using a small spoon.
- Cook until the edges are set and bubbles begin to form in the middle, about 3 minutes. Use a spatula to flip and cook another 2-3 minutes.

Top with sliced bananas and blueberries and enjoy!
