Pecan Apple Spice Cookies

Ingredients

1 1/2 c. all-purpose flour

2 tsp. cinnamon

1/2 tsp. baking soda

1/4 tsp. salt

1/2 c. unsalted butter

1/4 c. granulated sugar

1/4 c. brown sugar (packed)

1 large egg

1 1/2 tsp. vanilla extract

1 1/2 c. apple (chopped)

1 c. oats

1/2 c. chopped pecans

Instructions

- 1. Preheat overn to 350, clean area, wash apples.
- 2. In a small bowl, combine flour, cinnamon, baking soda, and salt. Set aside.
- 3. In a mixing bowl, mix with an electric mixer, sugar, brown sugar, egg and vanilla until smooth.
- 4. Slowly mix in flour mixture until smooth.
- 5. Fold in apples and pecans.
- 6. Form dough into 1" balls, place on cookie sheet, press down.
- 7. Bake at 350 for 6-8 minutes.
- 8. Remove from oven and serve warm for that yummy warm fall feeling.
