

INGREDIENTS

4 naan bread, whole wheat
8 ounces tomato sauce
2 cups zucchini, diced
2 cups mushrooms, diced
1 cup 2% mozzarella cheese, shredded
1 tsp olive oil
1/2 tsp black pepper

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Preheat oven to 475 F
- 2. Toss zucchini and mushrooms with olive oil and pepper.
- 3. Place vegetables on baking sheet and roast for 20-25 minutes.
- 4. Spread tomato sauce evenly on flatbread.
- 5. Sprinkle mozzarella over tomato sauce.
- 6. Add roasted vegetables.
- 7. Bake pizza at 400 F for 8-10 minutes until cheese is bubbly.
