



# **The Texas Master Gardener Program**

The Texas Master Gardener Program is a volunteer development program of Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service. Master Gardener volunteers receive in-depth horticultural training. In return, they provide volunteer service through AgriLife Extension by delivering horticultural education to their communities. Program participants should be able to communicate with the public by telephone, personal contact, as a speaker or through written correspondence. Master Gardener volunteers serve as "horticultural docents" supervised by AgriLife Extension personnel who assign, review and facilitate volunteer work.

### Step 1: To gain the title of Master Gardener Intern, a Trainee

- receives a minimum of fifty (50) hours of instruction
- passes an examination

The volunteer aspect of the Master Gardener program allows individuals to dedicate their time and talents to educate and enhance their local community utilizing the science and art of horticulture.

### Step 2: Master Gardener Interns:

- give 50 hours of volunteer service in AgriLife Extension initiated projects in Hood County within one year of their training date.
- are certified as a Master Gardener when all requirements are met

#### Step 3: Re-certification of a Master Gardener is an annual process that requires:

- 12 volunteer service hours
- 6 hours of continuing education credits

### Texas Master Gardener - Hood County - Application -2023

The Master Gardener training program is for twelve (12) months. Upon completion of all requirements, participants are certified as Texas Master Gardeners. Master Gardeners then re-certify annually through volunteer service and continuing education.
